



e-Learning - Digital Storytelling Project Hereford College of Arts

I have implemented the use of MP4 players and online spaces as teaching and learning resources. The Creative Zen MP4 Players are loaded with materials needed for a project about Digital Storytelling.



Digital Storytelling is the art of telling stories through the use of photography, film, graphics, typography and audio.

Resources include:

- Intro to Photoshop (animation) – Video from Powerpoint + handout
- Intro to Windows Movie Maker – Video from Powerpoint + hand out
- 'How to analyse images' - Video from Powerpoint + hand out
- Short examples of digital stories – video clips
- Interview with Daniel Meadows – video clip
- Blank storyboard – document
- Storyboarding examples – document
- Shooting schedule – document
- Project brief – document

The students can access this information at anytime from the players, and refer back when needed. The students keep hold of the players for the three week duration for the project.

At the end of the project students upload there own digital to the MP4 player for assessment and therefore creating new content and examples for future students to refer to.

Students/ young people are so used to interacting with interfaces such as mp3/ mp4/ ipod players and it means they can carry everything they need for the project in their pocket.
