Multimedia Podcasting Project: Worcester College of Technology

I am currently the “Molenet” (mobile learning) Champion, with a responsibility for the implementation of many innovative projects including:

Podcasting

I have made a number of podcasts ranging from assignment briefs to case studies which give a full commentary of the text.

D-Speech

I have used a program call D-Speech to turn a text document in to a WAV file and then converted it in to an MP3 file. This format can also be uploaded to Moodle, I-tunes or blue-toothed to a mobile phone.

Audacity

I have made a number of Podcasts using Audacity. This software enables me to make MP3 file of my voice and then turn it in to a Podcast. It can then be uploaded to Moodle or Blue-toothed to mobile phones.

Moviemaker using PowerPoint

After starting off with a standard PowerPoint presentation I have now developed a method to make these more interactive using Microsoft Moviemaker. Assisting those students with learning difficulties.

Moviemaker using video

To assist in certain lessons I have also made video productions.

I believe that learning should be portable. Which means it must be designed in a number of formats. This type of delivery has been exciting to do. It has also enabled me to reach certain learners who normally would have been left behind. Feedback from learners has been very positive!
