Young people and vulnerable adults on-line learning module: Worcester College of Technology

In Further Education all full time, part time, academic and business support staff have to undertake mandatory training on the safeguarding of children, young people and vulnerable adults.



As college Child Protection Officer I have devised an on-line course for staff that enables new staff to:

- understand the College quality framework for safeguarding children, young people and vulnerable adults;
- become aware of the possible signs of abuse and neglect;
- know to whom you should report any suspicions of neglect or abuse of children, young people or vulnerable adults.

On completion staff receive a certificate for their individual CPD file.

All types of staff will be engaging with the on-line course, including: estates workers, kitchen staff, cleaners etc. who do not all have access to computers at home and are not used to e-learning.

As this forms part of the mandatory health and safety training for all new staff and the on-line access means that it can be accessed and re-accessed whenever and wherever staff have the need or opportunity to review it.
